

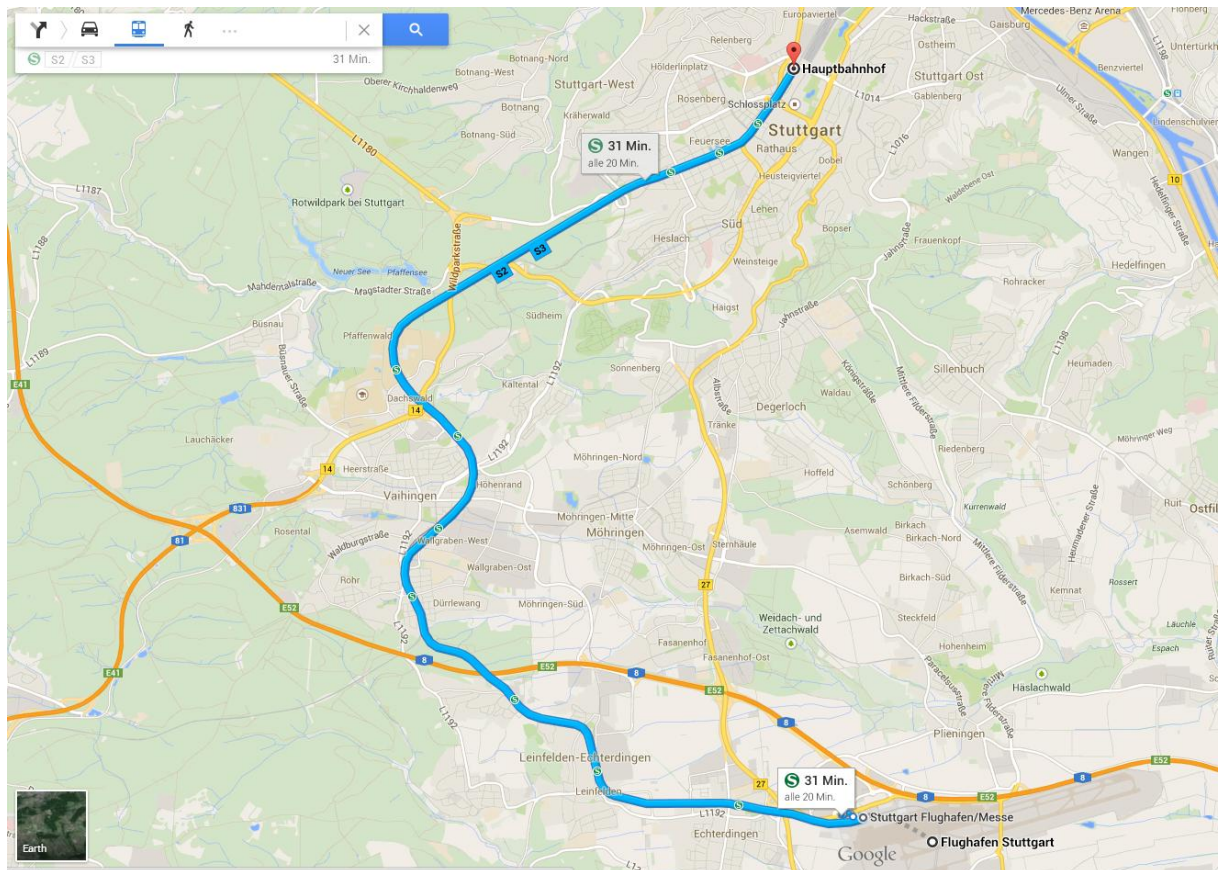


Arrival information

By plane:

By default you will be picked up at the airport, provided that you have entered your arrival time [here](#).

On your own: Stuttgart airport (Flughafen Stuttgart) is located south of the city. S-train lines S2 and S3 in direction of Schorndorf (S2) and Backnang (S3) take you downtown. The airport train station is located underground. The closest stop to the youth hostel would be Stuttgart Main Station (Hauptbahnhof or Hbf). From there on → see 'By train' (next page)

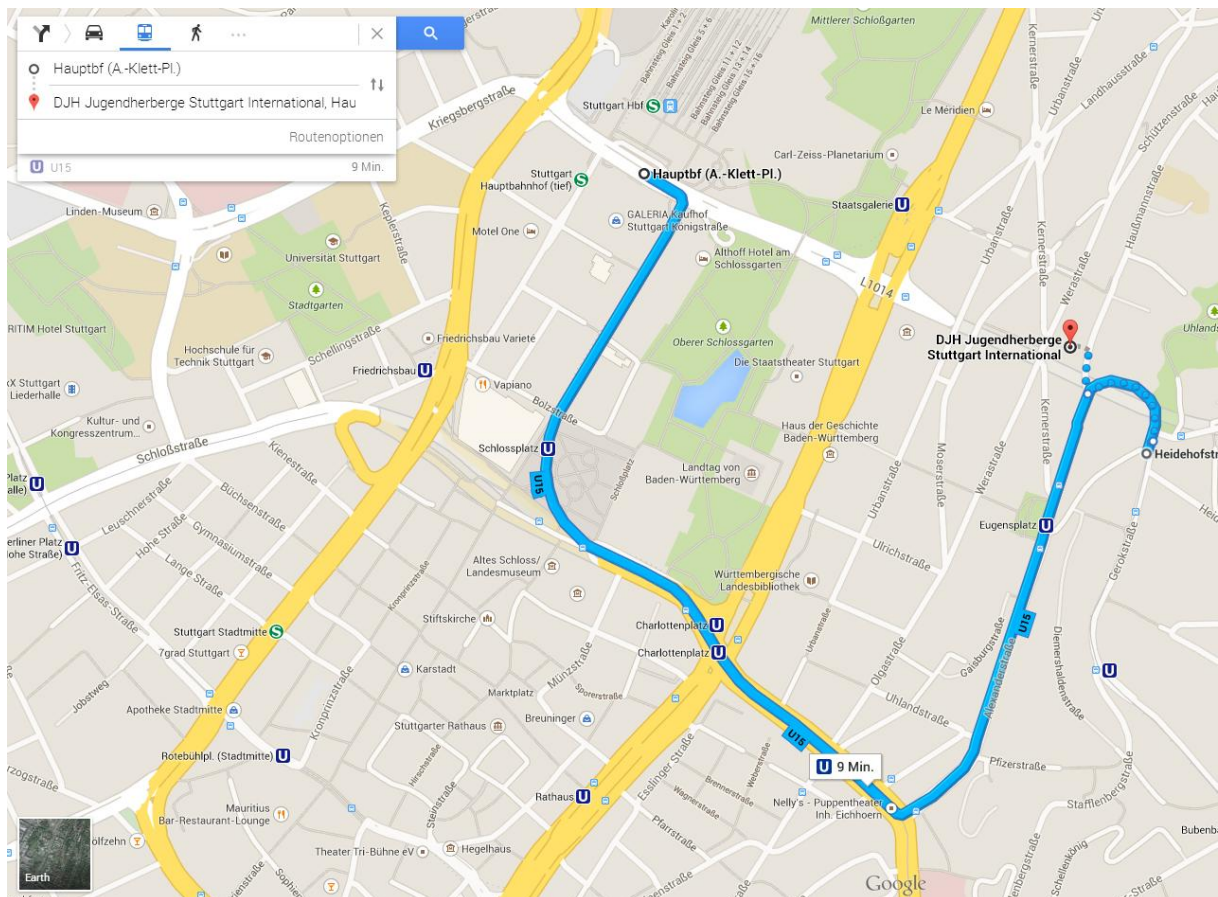


By train:

Train services (DB - 'Deutsche Bahn') to Stuttgart [see here](#).

By default you will be picked up at the main station, provided that you have entered your arrival time [here](#).

On your own: You need to get from Stuttgart Main Station (Hauptbahnhof or Hbf) to a U-train and disembark at 'Eugensplatz/Jugendherberge' or 'Heidehofstraße'. U15 in direction of 'Ruhbank'/'Heumaden' will take you to either of the two directly. From 'Eugensplatz' you need to walk further uphill, so 'Heidehofstraße' is a bit of an overshoot, but lets you get to the hostel by a downhill walk (may be preferable with lots of luggage).



By bus:

Depending on your entry point into Germany, you may want to consider a cost-efficient overland bus alternative to get to Stuttgart. By default you will be picked up at either bus stop, provided that you have entered your arrival time [here](#).
