The second possibility for the Tuesday is a visit to the Porsche Museum which was opened in 2009 and went on to win “Best of the Best” award in the category of “Architecture & Events” of the “Automotive Brand Contest 2011”



About 80 vehicles and many smaller exhibits get presented at the Porsche Museum, the collection includes not only the world-wide known models like the 356, 911 and 917, but also the technological master feats of Professor Ferdinand Porsche from the early 20<sup>th</sup> century. Even back then, the name “Porsche” was a synonym for never being satisfied with a technical solution until it lived up to the expectations of their creator.

At the Porsche Museum you will have the option to explore the exhibition on your own, or use one of the multi-lingual Audioguides free of charge.
